"In speaking with Mr. Kennedy early last month, I felt his message and information would be of great interest to the San Diego region and as such we are opening up the invitation to the wider community" says President & CEO, Bettina Hausmann. Hausmann continued, "The timing of the visit is great as our organization is celebrating its 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year. This is an opportunity to show once again how we San Diegans care deeply about culturally diverse communities, world issues, and the continuous work towards a just and equitable future for all. Assistant Secretary-General Kevin Kennedy is traveling from Jordan where a total of **329,135** Syrian refugee children are officially registered with UNHCR. A staggering **6,000,000** children are in desperate need inside Syria, while neighboring countries, Lebanon, Iraq, Turkey, Egypt and others, host additional **4,882,165** Syrian refugee children. These figures are even greater when considering the number of Syrian refugees in Europe.

During his visit on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016 the Regional Humanitarian Coordinator will update on the work of the United Nations in Syria, and its adjacent countries, focusing on the humanitarian side of the work as well as providing an overview on policy, operational and security challenges that further heighten the humanitarian crisis.

The event is scheduled for March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016 from 6 to 8 PM at the House of Pacific Relations in Balboa Park.
